1. Yes Holmen - A showcase of Holmen Area businesses and community groups and services with samples and giveaways. Held the last Sunday in February at the Holmen High School.
2. The Holmen Area Historical Society Driving Tour map listing all the historical sites in the area. Available at the Holmen Village Hall. Also the Society's large window display, which is periodically changed, can be seen in the main hallway. Ongoing fall events.
3. Deerwood Park - A 40 acre park complete with picnic areas, three ball fields, four tennis courts, a large play area, hockey rink, sledding hill, and 3 1/2 miles of rustic trails through 20 acres of forest.
4. The Historic Seven Bridges - McGilvary Road Trail features a pathway to the rare, restored bowstring arch bridges in the Van Loon Wildlife area on Wisconsin Rustic Road 64.
5. Holmen Aquatic Center open from Memorial Day through August.
6. The Holmen Community Theater puts on their shows during the 3rd and 4th weekends in July. Information available at (608) 526-9242.
7. Miss Holmen Pageant is held the 2nd Friday of August before the Kornfest at Holmen High School.
8. Kornfest - located downtown on Historic Main Street is always held on the 3rd weekend in August and features fireworks display on Friday evening, parade on Saturday, corn on the cob, music, carnival, tractor pulls, and the Kornfest Car and Motorcycle Show & Swap Meet on Sunday from 9 AM to 1 PM and Fun Run. 9. Halfway Creek Church annual Lutefisk Dinner on the 2nd Saturday in October.
10. Holmen Rod & Gun Club holds its Field Days Labor Day weekend. Mississippi Fandango Wild West Shootout at the Holmen Rod & Gun Club on the 2nd weekend of October.
11. The Majesty of Christmas held the Saturday after Thanksgiving features an outdoor Christmas Concert, Christmas Pageant with live animals, sleigh rides and petting zoo downtown on Main Street across from Village Hall.
12. Snowmobile trail maps are available at the Citgo gas station and Pizza Corral restaurant.
13. Biking on Great River Bike Trail, Holmen Halfway Creek Bike Trail connecting to Holland Bluffs Trail.
14. Wisconsin High School Regional Rodeo, Sponsored by Coulee Regional Rodeo Club on Labor Day Weekend.
15. Viking Field serves the Holmen High School Baseball league, the American Legion Baseball leagues, the Holmen Parents Youth Baseball Association Little League, and the Holmen Youth Tackle Football as well as many other community uses.
